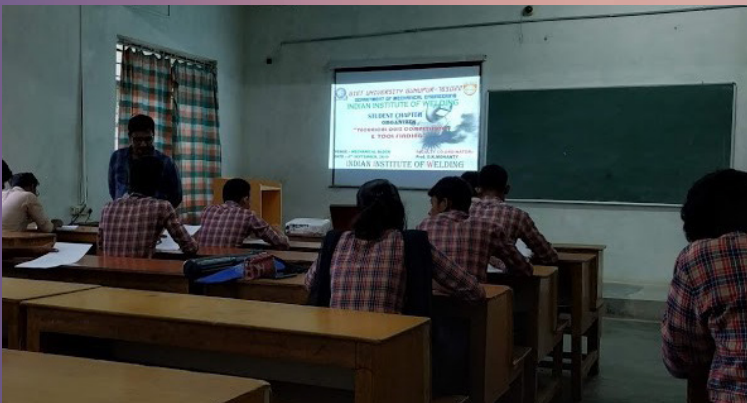




Department of Mechanical Engineering organized a Technical Design Competition on behalf of ASME student chapter on 28<sup>th</sup> Aug 2019.

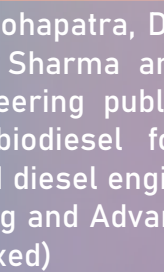
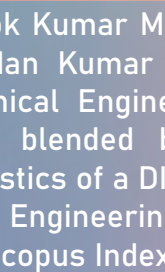
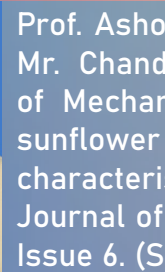
