Happy 75th Birthday to Our Beloved President Sir!

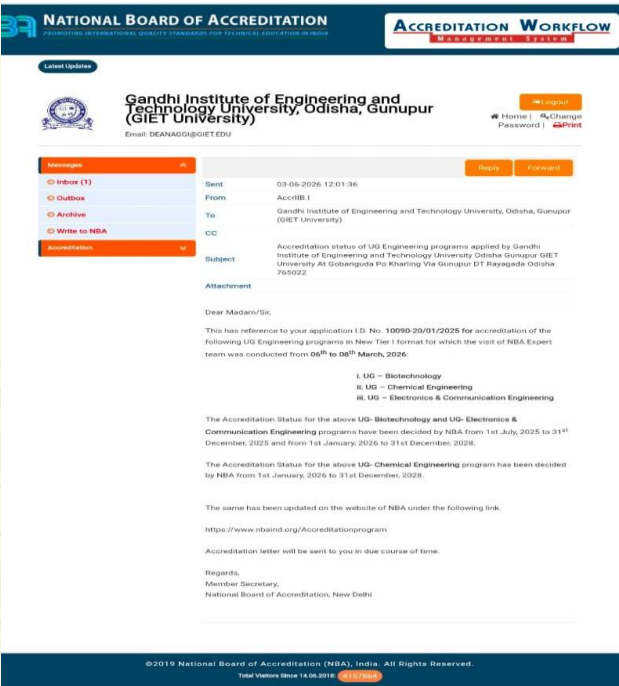

GIET University Receives Gold Award for Best Engineering University at ISDA Infracon National Awards 2026

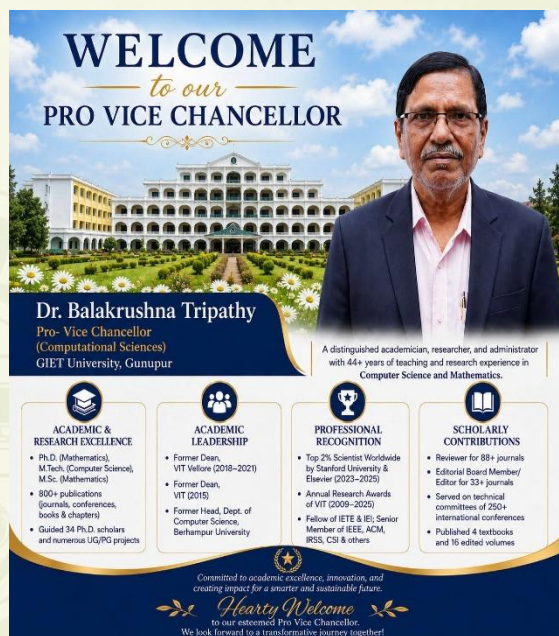

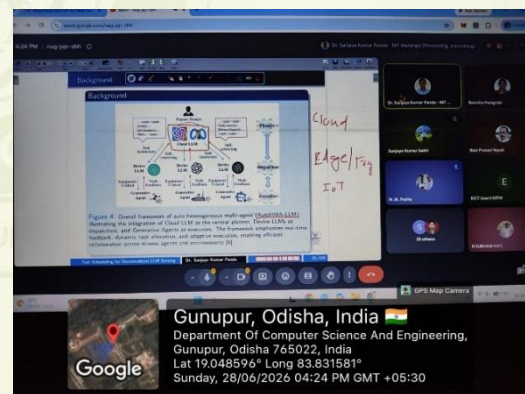
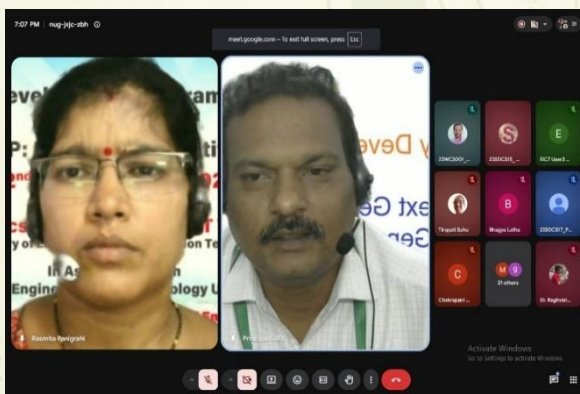

This prestigious assignment reflects the growing confidence of ICAR-IIMR in the research capabilities and academic excellence of the School of Agriculture. The collaborative research initiative aims to evaluate the performance of diverse finger millet varieties by following the prescribed Standard Operating Protocols (SOPs), contributing to the development of improved millet cultivation practices and sustainable agriculture.

The achievement marks yet another feather in the cap of the School of Agriculture and further strengthens GIET University's commitment to agricultural research, innovation, and national development. The University congratulates the faculty members and researchers involved in this initiative and looks forward to successfully executing the trials in accordance with the highest scientific standards.

Expert Talk Highlights Research and Extension Activities under AICRP on Castor

On 27 June 2026, the School of Agriculture, GIET University, organised an expert lecture by Prof. (Dr.) Susanta Kumar Mohanty, Professor of Genetics and Plant Breeding, on "Research and Extension Activities under the All India Coordinated Research Project (AICRP) on Castor."

During the session, Prof. Mohanty highlighted the economic importance of castor and its diverse industrial applications, while presenting an overview of its cultivation, production, and productivity in India, with special emphasis on Odisha. He explained the crop's botany, floral biology, reproductive behaviour, and breeding techniques, including emasculation and hybridization, followed by recommended agronomic practices for successful castor cultivation.

The speaker also discussed integrated weed, pest, and disease management strategies, emphasizing sustainable approaches such as the use of pendimethalin for pre-emergence weed control and sunhemp as a green manure crop. Detailed insights into major insect pests, diseases, and their integrated management were supported by field photographs illustrating crop growth stages, pest infestation, and disease symptoms.

The lecture further covered crop evaluation parameters, harvesting techniques, post-harvest management, and seed yield estimation. Prof. Mohanty concluded by highlighting the research and extension activities carried out under the AICRP on Castor, including Front Line Demonstrations (FLDs), farmer awareness programmes, market surveys, and technology dissemination initiatives aimed at promoting improved castor cultivation practices among farming communities.

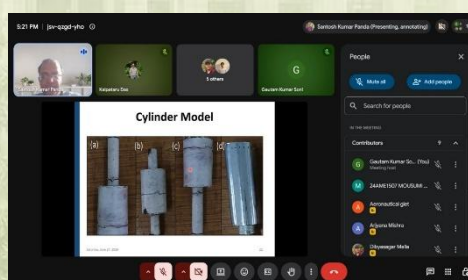

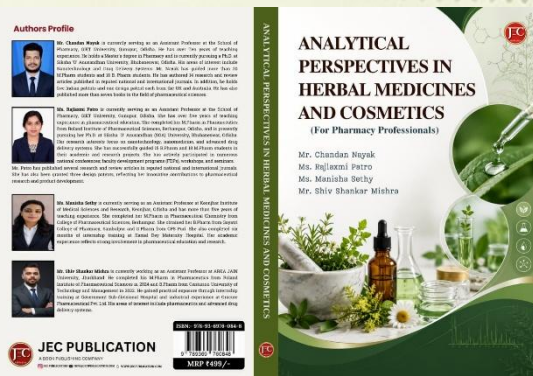

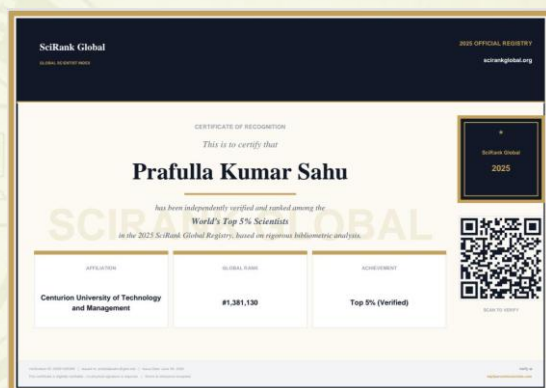
